

Opportunities for Arts Patronage & Support

Annual Patronage Membership

Birch Patron/Member – €1,000 per annum. This introductory level of patronage offers a meaningful way to become part of the organisation's circle of supporters. It helps sustain the year-round artistic programme and contributes to the conditions in which artists can research, reflect and create.

Oak Patron/Member – €2,000 per annum. This enhanced level of annual patronage offers patrons a more substantial way to support artists and contribute to the cultural life of the organisation. Support at this level strengthens programming, nurtures creative practice and helps provide continuity for artists and audiences alike.

Woodland Ecology & Arts Programme Patronage

Programme Patron – €3,000 per annum. Patronage of the Woodland Symposium Ecology & Art Programme supports a distinctive meeting point between artistic practice, ecology and place. It enables artists, ecologists and audiences to explore landscape, environment and creativity together, while allowing patrons to support work that is thoughtful, rooted and responsive to the natural world.

Named Artist Residency Patronage

Named Residency Patron – €8,000 per annum. This level of patronage fully supports a four-week residency for one artist and creates a direct, personal connection between the patron and the development of new work. Offered in the patron's name, it provides an artist with time, space and support at an important moment in their practice.

This patronage includes an artist's bursary of €2,800, accommodation costs and a contribution towards the organisation's core overheads, ensuring the residency is properly resourced and accessible. It is a tangible way to invest in artistic development and to accompany an artist's work from idea to realisation.

Named Studio-Residential Unit Patronage

Our ambition is to develop eco-friendly artist accommodation that sits sensitively within the woodland environment, strengthening the connection between artistic practice, ecology and place. In this way, patronage of a studio/residential unit supports not only the creation of vital working and living space for artists, but also a broader vision of sustainable cultural infrastructure rooted in the landscape.

Capital Patron – €20,000–€50,000. This substantial level of patronage contributes to the development of our planned new studio/residential unit, helping to expand the organisation's capacity to welcome and support artists. It offers patrons the opportunity to take part in shaping the physical environment in which future artistic work will be made.

Legacy Patron – €100,000. This exceptional level of patronage enables the creation of a fully equipped studio/residential unit in the patron's name. It represents a lasting cultural legacy, providing dedicated space for artists to live, work, experiment and develop ambitious new projects for generations to come.
